Thomas Cracknall (son of John Cracknall, dec) chooses John Hebborn his Guardian. And that the said John Hebborn bring the said orphan to the next Court to be held for said County to be bound out.

William Glaspin acknowledges a conveyance for fifty acres of land part of a tract of land called Richards Adventure to Joseph Wright. Mary Glaspin wife of the said William Glaspin being privately examined by W<sup>m</sup> Marmaduke Siden one of the Justices of the said County. Court acknowledges the same without being riduce thereto by fear or threats used by her said husband.

The orphan Jury returns and delivers a presentment to the Court against William Graves for not learning the orphan of James Gallaway his trade as he was obliged to by William Gallaway and consents that forme not touching substance may be altered.

Whereas Abigail Parsons and Milt Parsons orphans of John Parsons dec. being bound to Samuel Parsons of Duane County And the said Samuel being obliged by bond during the time the said orphans are to serve him to bring them to June Court every year that the Court might enquire whether they were well dealt with and the said Samuel Parsons with the said orphans appearing and nothing being offered on which this Court orders them to him againe.
