John Peterzenger Sworn as an Lord and Sent to the Grand Jury This Court hath agreed with John Parle for repairing the Court house to which he hath given bond for performing the same by the 15<sup>th</sup> June next and to have allowed him in the next Term 55000. he giving good bond & Sureties to perform the same according to agreement

Margrett Littman a poor child bound by Indenture to Daniel Roche to be kept to common Labour until she shall arrive at the age Twenty one years she being three years old the 7<sup>th</sup> day of April next to learn her the Creed Lord's prayer and Ten Commandments in the vulgar tongue and to have her baptized

The above Indenture signed Sealed Delivered and acknowledged in Court

Court adjourns till tomorrow morning eight Clocks
