Proclamation the appearance Docket is going to be called over as follo.

Nath. Hynson - CHARLES absolute Lord & proprietarie
Murlough Mahoney of the province of Maryland and Avalon
Lord Barron of Baltimore &c To the Sheriff
of Kent County greeting We Command you that you Attach any
the Goods Chattels Rights or Credits of Murlough Mahoney of Kent
County planter if they shall be found in your Bailiwick to the
value of four pounds four shillings and six pence current money
of the province and twelve hundred pounds of Tobacco and
when you have the same so attached or any part thereof the same in
your Custody safe keep so that you have them before the Justices of our
next County Court to be held at our Court house in the Town of Chester in
P. County on the third Tuesday in June next then and there to be Cendemed
according to act of assembly to and for the use of a certain Nathaniell
Hynson unless he the said Murlough Mahoney by him self or his
Attorney shall appear and answer unto the said Nathaniell Hynson
in a plea of Trespas on the case according to Law and that by good and
Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the person or per-
son in whose hands in whose hands you make same attachment that
he or they be and appear before the Justices of our said Court to be held
as afo. to show Cause if any he she or they have why the same Goods Chattels
Rights or Credits so attached in his or their hands ought not to be Cendemed
