I. Proclamation the appearance Dockett is going to be called
over as fol^t. Viz^t

M. Nath^t Hynson — I Charles absolute Lord & proprie^rarie
Marlough Mahoney of the province of Maryland and Colon^y
Lord Barron of Baltimore &c To the Sheriff
of Kent County Greeting We command you that you attack any
the Goods Chattles Rights or Credits of Marlough Mahoney of Kent
County planter if they shall be found in your Bailywick to the
value of four pounds fourteen shillings and six pence Current money
of the province of and twelve hundred pounds of Tobacco and
when you have the same to attached or any part thereof the same in
your Custodys Safe keepe to that you have them before the Justices of our
next County Court to be held at our Court house in the Town of Chester in
County on the third Tuesday in June next then and there to be condemned
according to acts of Assembly to and for the use of a certain Nathaniell
Hynson unless the said Marlough Mahoney by him self or his
Attorney shall appear and answer unto the said Nathaniell Hynson
in a plea of Tresspass on the Case according to Law and that by good and
Lawfull men of your Bailywick you make known unto the person or per-
sons in whose hands in whose hands you make same attachment that
he she or they be and appear before the Justices of our said Court to be held
as oft to New Cause if any he she or they have why the same Goods Chattles
Rights or Credits so attached in his or their hands ought not to be condemn^{ned}
