by virtue of the Writt hereto annexed to me directed vizt. on the
tenth day of June Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and twenty
at the County and Jurisdiction in the Writt mentioned place attached
of the Goods and Chattels Rights and Credits of Mortough Mahoney
in the Writt mentioned before good and Lawfull men of my Bailiwick
vizt. in the hands of Jacob Glen the Sum of Seven hundred
pounds of Tobacco before John Wilson and John Hugg of the value of
two pounds Eighteen Shillings and four pence Current money of Maryland
and in the hands of John Ingram before Fredrick Hanson and
John Cooper the Sum of four hundred and fifty pounds of Tobacco
of the value one pound seven shillings & six pence Current money
aforesaid and also in the hands of Owen Whally before Thomas Gideons and
Thomas Synson Seven hundred pounds of Tobacco of the value of
two pounds Eighteen Shillings and four pence Current money to satisfy
of Nathaniell Synson in the Writt mentioned in part of four hundred
fourteen Shillings & six pence Current money and twelve hundred
pounds of Tobacco in the Writt mentioned and have the same here ready
to be Charged and sold as in the Writt mentioned for the use of the said
Nathaniell Synson and also at the time place in the Writt mentioned
have made known to the said Jacob Glen before John Wilson & John Hugg
good and Lawfull men of my Bailiwick and to the said John Ingram before
Fredrick Hanson & John Cooper good & Lawfull men of my Bailiwick
and to the said Owen Whally before Thomas Gideons and Thomas Synson
Good and Lawfull men of my Bailiwick that they be and appear before the
Justices in the Writt named at the time and place in the Writt
mentioned to show Cause if he or they or any of them have why the Goods &
Chattels Rights & Credits attached aforesaid should not be condemned as the
Writt Requires
