 as his Costs and Charges accrued by occasion of the p^rmisses a^s.

All whereupon the a^s. Severall persons altho severally & solemnly called
 come not but make Default nor does any other person appear or shew
 Cause.

There upon James Smith of Kent County Genl. p^r. sent herein Court
 Undertakes for the a^s. Nathaniel Hyson that in case the a^s. Murtough
 Mahoney shall at any time within a year and a day appear and make all
 or any part of the a^s. Nathaniel Hyson his Claim a^s. him appear
 to be Satisfied or otherwise to have been undue before the laying of this
 Attachment that then the a^s. Nathaniel Hyson shall make Restitution
 the Said Murtough Mahoney of all or such part there of as shall be made
 appear to be undue &c. or that he the a^s. James Smith will do it for him

Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here the 28th Day of July
 anno Dom. 1720. a^s. that the said Summ of Seven hundred pounds of Tobacco
 of the a^s. value of two pounds Eighteen ^{paid four pence} Shillings Current money. So as

 pounds of Tobacco of the a^s. value of two pounds Eighteen Shillings and
 four pence money a^s. So as a^s. attached in the hands of Owen shall
 be Condemned in the hands of Severall persons a^s. as of the Goods &
 Chattles Rights and Credits of the a^s. Murtough Mahoney towards
 Satisfying unto the a^s. Nathaniel Hyson as well his Damages reco-
 vered in the plea a^s. as his Costs and Charges accrued by occasion of
 the p^rmisses a^s. &c. and that the a^s. Nathaniel Hyson have his Execu-
 tion against the a^s. Severall persons according to Act of Assembly &c.
