 Murtough Mahony Slave & Abalone Lord Barron of Baltimore &c. To the Sheriff of Kent County Great
 We Command you that you attach any the goods Chattels Rights or Credits of Murtough Mahony of Kent County Plaintiff if they shall be found in your Bailiwick to the value of four thousand three hundred pounds of Tobacco, and when you have the same so attached or any part thereof the same in your Custody safe keep so that you have them before the Justices of our next County Court to be held at our Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in June next then and there to be condemned according to act of Assembly to and for the use of a certain James Cuckshank unless the said Murtough Mahony by himself or his Attorney shall appear and answer unto the said James Cuckshank in a plea of Trespass of the Case according to Law and that by good and Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the same Attachment that he she or they be and appear before the Justices of our Court to be held as aforesaid to show Cause if any he she or they have why the same goods Chattels Rights or Credits be attached in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned according to Law if so him her or them it shall seem meet and how you shall Execute this writ that you make known unto our Justices at the day and place aforesaid and have you then and there this writ Witness Math.  I do hereby Certify to the Justices within mentioned that on the 6th day of April in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand Seven hundred and Twenty I have attached in the hands of James Harris Esq. at Eastern Neck hundred in Kent County within the Jurisdiction of this Court five hundred pounds of Tobacco of the property goods of the within mentioned Murtough Mahoney before Abraham Redgrave
