and make all or any part of the S: James Cuckshank his Claim ag-
him appear to be satisfied or otherwise to have been undue be-
fore the laying of this attachment that then the S: James Cuckshank
shall make Restitution unto him the S: Murlough Mahony of all or
such part thereof as shall be made appear to be undue or that he the
Said David Macbride will doe it for him

Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here the 28th day
of July Anno Dom 1720 that the Said Summ of five hundred
pounds of Tobacco So as as attached in the hands of James Harris
Esq: as: be Condemned in the hands of the Same James Harris
as of the Goods Chattels Rights or Credits of the S: Murlough Maho-
ney towards Satisfying unto the S: James Cuckshank as well part of
his damages Recovered in the plea as: as part his Costs and Charges
accrued by occasion of the S: premises as: and that the S: James Cuckshank
have his Execution against the S: James Harris according to act
