In Kent County in Maryland <sup>the</sup> George Macay of Kent County Planter als died George Macay of Kent County and of the province aforesd planter was summoned to answer unto Phillip McLeadger of a plea that he render him the full and just Sum of Seven thousand two hundred pounds of good sound merchantable Lease Tobacco and Cashe to contain the same of the value of Seventy two pounds. Perd money which from him he unjustly detains &c And whereupon the afd ptd by David Macbride his Attorney. hath that whereas the afd Def<sup>t</sup> the twenty fourth day of February in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and Eighty at Throssberry parish in Kent County within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his Certain Writing Obligatory which he the afd Def<sup>t</sup> sealed with his Seal & as his deed delivered here into Court brought the date whereof is the Sunday and year afd Granted himself holden & firmly bound unto the afd ptd. in the afd full and just Sum of Seven thousand two hundred pounds of good sound merchantable Lease Tobacco in Cashe to contain the same of the afd value of Seventy two pounds. Perd money to be paid unto the afd ptd. when thereunto required. Nevertheless the afd Def<sup>t</sup> altho often required the afd full and just Sum of Seven thousand two hundred pounds of good sound merchantable Lease Tobacco and Cashe to contain the same to the afd ptd. hath not paid but that to him to render or pay hitherto hath denyed and still doth deny & unjustly detain to the damage of him the afd ptd. Seventy two pounds Perd money and thereupon he brings Suite &c

Whereupon at the prayer of the ptd. the Def<sup>t</sup> is adjudged to give Special Bail to the afd ptd. Thereupon Robert Macay of Kent County Planter ofent here in Court undertakes for the afd George Macay that in case the afd Phillip McLeadger shall recover Judgement in the plea afd ag<sup>t</sup> the afd George Macay or that he the afd George Macay shall be therein Convict that then he the afd George Macay shall pay the Condemnation of the Court thereupon or render his Body to the Custody of the Sheriff of Kent County in Satisfaction thereof or that the afd Robert Macay will do it for him

And now at this Court viz<sup>t</sup> the 28<sup>th</sup> day of July anno Dom 1720 the afd Def<sup>t</sup> here present in Court in his proper person Comes and defends the force and Injury when &c. And says that he cannot gainsay the ptd his action afd. So as afd against him brought, Nor can he say but that the afd ptd ought to recover his Debt by occasion of the afd imp<sup>er</sup>
