Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here the 28th day of July
anno Dom 1720 a^d that the ^d Arthur Miller recover recover a^d the
^d Joseph Wood as well the sum of one thousand six hundred and
seventy two pounds of Tobacco his debt a^d in form a^d Confessed as also
the sum of Two hundred and sixty two pound of Tobacco
by the Court here adjudged to him for his Costs and Charges by him
about this Suit in this behalfe laid out and expended and the De^f
in mercy &c.
