Whereupon at the prayer of the p<sup>r</sup> the Def<sup>t</sup> is adjudged to give Special Bail to the action a<sup>d</sup>. Thereupon William Mackey of Kent County present herein Court undertakes for the J. Robert Maxfield that in case the J. Gilbert Higginson and Company shall recover Judgem<sup>t</sup> against the J. Robert Maxfield in the plea a<sup>d</sup>. or that he the J. Robert Maxfield shall therein be Convict that then he the J. Robert Maxfield shall pay the Condemnation of the Court thereupon or render his body into the Custody of the Sheriff of Kent County in Satisfaction thereof or that he the J. William Mackey will do it for him.

And now at this Court viz<sup>t</sup> the 28<sup>th</sup> day of July anno Dom 1720 the a<sup>d</sup> Def<sup>t</sup> here in Court present in his proper person comes and defends the force and injury when &c. And say<sup>s</sup> that he cannot gainsay the p<sup>r</sup> a<sup>d</sup> their action. As a<sup>d</sup> against him brought nor can he say but that the p<sup>r</sup> ought to recover their debt by occasion of the premises a<sup>d</sup> to the Summ of Six hundred and Seventy four pounds of Tobacco and Cost of Suit against him which the p<sup>r</sup> doth not gainsay. Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here the 28<sup>th</sup> day of July anno Dom 1720 that the J. Gilbert Higginson & Comp<sup>y</sup>. Recover against the J. Robert Maxfield as well the Summ of Six hundred and Seventy four pounds of Tobacco his Damages a<sup>d</sup> in form a<sup>d</sup>. as also the Summ of three hundred and twenty seven pounds of Tobacco
