ordered by the Justices here the 29th day of July Anno Domini 1720 a^{ss}
that the a^{ss} Elizabeth Marshey as to the a^{ss} Indictment go thence without day
and that she be therefrom acquitted, but that the a^{ss} Elizabeth Marshey pay the
sum of Eight hundred and forty
pounds of Tobacco by the Court here adjudged to her for her
Costs and Charges accruing on the premises a^{ss} to the officers of this Court

Lordship

Recognizance taken last Court for his appearance to this
Court and Good behaviour, and now that he appears
in proper person the Court here orders his Recognizance
and his Sureties Recognizances for his appearance and good behaviour to
be discharged.

Robert Brown a^{ss} Entered into Recognizance the time a^{ss} in the sum
of five pounds Sterling money to be levied on his Goods and Chattels Lands
and Tenements Conditionally that if he does not make his personal appearance
here at this Court to answer what shall be objected against him on his Lordships
behalf and in the mean time to be of good behaviour. And no person appearing
to show Cause to the contrary why the a^{ss} Recognizance should not be discharged the
Court here discharges the same.

Robert Brown and Peter Mary Entered into Recognizance in the sum
of five pounds Sterling money each to be levied on their Goods and Chattels
Lands and Tenements Conditionally that if the a^{ss} Robert Brown should
not make his personal appearance here to answer a^{ss} and in the mean
time to be of good behaviour. This Court here discharges the same Recognizance
each of them.
