The Jurors for the hon^{ble} the D^d Proprietary & the Body of Kent County on their oath do present that Elizabeth Baker wife of a certain Merchantman called Anthony Baker late of Easter neck hundred the tenth day of October in the Year of our Lord Christ one thousand Seven hundred and Nineteen at Easter Neck hundred a^p in 2^d pauls Parish in Kent County within the Jurisdiction of this Court and at divers other times the fear of God before her Eyes not having but by the Instigation of the Devil & do hereby did Commit to the high displeasure of Almighty God against the peace of our S^d Lord pro^p his rule and dignity and against the form of an Act of Assembly of this province now in force in such Case made and provided Maurice & 2^d pro^p Eric Fred Hansen Edw^d Davis and William Roberts

On the Back of the preceding Indictment was Endorsed as follow^{ing} Billa Vera Abra^m Redgrave freeman

And the a^p Elizabeth Baker in her proper person Comes and Defends the force and Injury when &c. and appears to the a^p Indictm^t and the a^p David Maubride Clerk of the Indictments Comes into Court and saith that he hath not Sufficient Evidence to prove the Premises in the a^p Indictment Upon which by Consent of the Court he Enter^s that the D^d Indictment be no further prosecuted and that all proceedings thereon cease but that the D^d Elizabeth Baker pay the fees on the same Indictment amounting to three hundred and Sixty Eight pounds of Tobacco
