The Jurors for the Hon: the P^{ro} and the Body of Hert County on their oath be present that Mary Bateman wife of a certain Christopher Bateman late of Chester hundred the fifteenth day of February in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand Seven hundred and Nineteen at Chester hundred a^d. in P^{ar} Pauls parish in Hert County within the jurisdiction of this Court and at diverse other times and places the fear of God before her Eyes not having but by the instigation of the Devil & adultery did Commit with a certain Peter Green to the high displeasure of Almighty God to the evil and pernicious Example of others Against the peace of our P^{ro} his Rule and Dignity and against the form of an Act of Assembly of this province now in force in such Case made and provided

Macbride Clerk of the Indictments Comes into Court and saith that he hath not sufficient Evidence to prove the Crimes in the a^d. Indictment upon which by Consent of the Court he Enters that the P^{ro} Indictment be no further prosecuted, and that all proceedings thereon cease but that the P^{ro} Mary Bateman pay the fees on the same Indictment amounting to three hundred and Ninety pounds of Tobacco

Order That the Sher of County keep the a^d. Mary Bateman in safe Custody until y^e fees a^d. amounting to three hundred and Nine pounds of Tobacco
Whereupon Christopher Bateman her Husband sheweth in Court that he will pay the fees a^d. amounting to the a^d. Sum of three hundred and Nine pounds of Tobacco to whom the same is dis
