The Grand Jury for the body of Kent County this Court did make a presentment against the a^d Edward Dwire for breaking prison out of the Custody of Simon Wilmer Gent. High Sheriff of P^r County which Presentment was by David Macbride Clerk of Judiciments formed into a Bill of Indictment as follows

Kent County S^t The Jurors for the Hon^{ble} the Lord Proprietary that now is and the Body of Kent County on their Oath do present that whereas a certain Edward Dwire late of South Sassafras upper hundred in Shrewsbury parish in Kent County within the jurisdiction of this Court Yeoman the fifteenth day of Aprile in the Year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and Nineteen at the hundred parish County within the jurisdiction a^d by virtue and force of a writ issued out of P^r County Court directed to the Sheriff of P^r County dated the twenty first day of march in the Year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and Nineteen was taken and by Simon Wilmer Gent. then and there Sheriff of the a^d County into the Goal of our P^r Lord Proprietary in the County a^d in the Custody of the a^d Simon Wilmer Gent. then and now Sheriff of the County a^d there to remain and safely to be kept till such time as according to Law & Customs of our P^r Lord Prop^r he should be delivered he the a^d Edward Dwire was committed Nevertheless the a^d Edward Dwire in the Goal a^d under the Custody of the a^d Simon Wilmer Gent. then and now Sheriff of the County a^d at Easter hundred in St Pauls parish in Kent County within the jurisdiction a^d the twenty fifth day of Aprile in the Year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and twenty by Usual form of Law being the twenty sixth day of Aprile in the Year last mentioned the P^r Goal of our P^r Prop^r in Kent County a^d at the hundred parish County and within the Jurisdiction last mentioned feloniously did brake and out of the P^r Goal in the Custody of the a^d Simon Wilmer Gent. then Sheriff of P^r County then and there last mentioned feloniously did go and Escape against the peace of our P^r Prop^r his
