any the Goods Chattells Rights or Credits of Simon Tillet of Kent County Planter, if they shall be found in your Bailiwick to the value of Nine Thousand pounds of Tobacco & when y^e have the Same so attached or any part thereof the Same in y^e Custody safe keep so that y^e have them before the Justices of our next County Court to be held at our Court House in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in June next then & there to be condemned according to Act of Assembly to & for the use of a certain Peter Head unless he the said Simon Tillet by himself or his atty shall appear & answer unto the said Peter Head in a plea of Trespass upon the Case according to Law and that by good & Lawfull men of y^e Baywick y^e make known unto the Person or persons in whose hands y^e make y^e Same attachment that he she or they be and appear before the Justices of our said Court to be held as aforesaid to show cause if any he she or they have why the Same goods Chattells rights or Credits so attached in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned according to Law if to him or them it shall seem meet and necessary. I shall write this writ that y^e make known unto our said Justices at the day & place aforesaid and have y^e then and there this writ Witness Nathaniel Hyson Gent. Chief Justice of our said Court this 25. day of March in the second year of our Dominion &c. Anno Domini 1717

At which said next Court viz. the seventeenth day of June Anno Domini one Thousand Seven hundred and Eighteen the day of Return of said writ came Simon Wilmer Gent. High Sheriff of said County and made return thereof in these words thereon endorsed as foloweth. By virtue of the within writ to me directed & certified to the Justices within mentioned that I have attached of the Goods and Chattells of the within named Simon Tillet one Sorrell horse one Saddle one bridle of the price & value of Six hundred pounds of Tobacco in the hands of the within named Peter Head to satisfy unto the said Peter Head part of the Sum of Nine Thousand pounds of Tobacco and have made indentments to the said Peter Head that he be and appear at the time and place within mentioned to show cause if any he has why the said Goods and Chattells attached as aforesaid ought not to be condemned according to Law before James Murphey & John Cooper two good & Lawfull men of my Baywick and so I do swear

and the appt by Thomas Brown his atty pray judgment for condemnation of the aforesaid Sorrell horse Saddle & bridle of the aforesaid price & value of Six hundred pounds of Tobacco: Therefore it is considered by the Court here viz. the eighteenth day of June Anno Domini One Thousand Seven hundred and Eighteen that the aforesaid Sorrell horse Saddle & bridle of the price and value of Six hundred pounds of Tobacco the goods and Chattells of the aforesaid Debt be condemned to the use of the aforesaid p^{ty} and that the aforesaid p^{ty} have thereof Execution he the said p^{ty} giving Surety before Execution be made that if the aforesaid Debt by himselfe or his atty should come in and appeare to the originale avow within a year and a day and make it appear that the Same is satisfied or any part thereof
