# Thereupon

Undertakes for the said Edward Mitchell. That in case the said Josiah Richardson shall at any time within a year and a day appear, and make all or any part of the aforesaid Edward Mitchell his Cause against him appear to be satisfied or otherwise to have been undue before the laying on of this attachment that then the said Edward Mitchell shall make Restitution to the said Josiah Richardson of all or such part thereof as shall be made appear to be undue &c. or that he the said  
will do it for him

Therefore it is Considered by the Court here this 17<sup>th</sup> of August anno 1720. that the aforesaid Sum of one thousand pounds of Tobacco of the aforesaid value of four pounds three Shillings and four pence Current money so as aforesaid attached in the hands of Hermanus Phelps, as also the aforesaid Sum of four hundred pounds of Tobacco of the aforesaid value of one pound thirteen Shillings and four pence Current money aforesaid so as aforesaid attached in the hands of William Norton, as also the aforesaid Sum of three hundred and thirty three pounds of Tobacco of the aforesaid value of one pound Six Shillings and Six pence so as aforesaid attached in the hands of John Greenwood be Condemned in the hands of the several persons aforesaid as the Goods and Chattels Rights and Credits of the aforesaid Josiah Richardson towards Satisfying to the aforesaid Edward Mitchell as well part of his Damages recover'd in the plea aforesaid as part of his Costs and Charges accruing on the premises aforesaid and that the said Edward Mitchell have his Execution against the several persons aforesaid according to Act of assembly &c.
