Bail which you make known unto the said Thomas Cook that he be and appear before the Justices of our next County Court to be held at our Court house in the Town of Quarter in said County on the third Tuesday in June next to shew cause if any he have why execution should not issue forth against him for the Debt & Costs in Judgment as specified and how you shall recite this writ that you make known unto the Justices of our said Court at the day & place as hereof failed not of your power and have you then and there the names of 4 persons before whom you shall make the same known and his writ Witness Nathaniel Hanson Gent. chief Justice of our said Court this 21. day of March in the 31. year of our Dominion &c. Anno Domini 1717

At which said Court in the afove writ in the last place mentioned on the seven twenty day of June Anno Domini One thousand seven hundred and Eighteen the day of return of said writ came Simon Wilmer Gent. High Sheriff of said County & made return thereof in these words Thereon endorsed a said writ By virtue of the within writ I am directed & certified unto the Justices within mentioned that I have made known unto the within named Thomas Cook that he be and appear before the Justices within mentioned at the time and place within mentioned to shew cause if any he have why execution should not issue forth against him for the Debt & Costs in the Judgment within mentioned before Nathaniel Hanson & Thomas Welden Esqrs. and Eusebius men of my Bailwick and so do officers Simon Wilmer Sheriff

and the afove Deft. comes into Court and in his proper person appears to the above Sirs saying and saying that he cannot pay the same but is willing that Judgment should be entered for the Debt & Costs in the Sirs afove above mentioned amounting to one thousand five hundred twenty four pounds of Tobacco: Therefore it is considered by the Court here on the 15. day of June Anno Domini One thousand seven hundred and Eighteen That for the afove sum of Twelve hundred pounds of Tobacco Debt in the Judgment as specified as also for the sum three hundred twenty four pounds of Tobacco in the Judgment as specified which in the whole amounts to the sum of fifteen hundred twenty four pounds of Tobacco that the afove Deft. have thereby execution against the said Deft. as also for the sum of two hundred eighty six pounds of Tobacco of the afove Deft. about their presenting the afove writ of Sirs afove
