 body before his said Lord Ships Justices of the next Court to be held at our Court house in
 the town of Chester in said County to answer unto James Knowles of a plea that he
 render unto him the full and just sum of five hundred and forty six pounds of Tobacco —
 which from him he unjustly detains &c. and that he have then and there the
 said writ &c.

 of said writ came Simon Wilmer Gent. High Sheriff of said County and made
 return thereof in these words thereon Endorsed as follows viz. Satisfaction had by
 and the said Deft being called came and the said p^{ts} by John Johnson his atty
 prays that the said Deft may give special baile to the a^{pp} a^{pp} which is granted
 and that he be kept in safe custody by the Sheriff of said County until he shall give
 special baile as a^{pp}.

After which Peter Green of said County came into Court and acknowledged himselfe
