 Kent County the twenty first day of March in
 the second Year of his Lordships Dominion &c
 that he take John Frew of Kent County Planter
 if he shall be found in his Bailynick and him safe keep so that he have

 Court in the Town of Chester in said County to Answer unto William Glanville
 of said County Inholder of a plea of Trepass of the Case And that he have
 then and there this writ &c All which said next Court viz the seventeenth day
 of June Annoque Domini one thousand seven hundred and eighteen the
 day of Return of said writ Came Simon Wilmer Gent: high Sheriff of said
 County and made return thereof in these words thereon Endorsed as followeth
 viz Capi Corpus p Simon Wilmer Sher and a declaration being filed
 when said writ issued and a Copy thereof served therewith According
 to Act of Assembly in such Case made was as followeth viz
 Kent County Jt: John Frew of Kent County Planter stands attached to
 Answer unto William Glanville of said County Inholder of a Plea of Trepass
 of the Case ——— And whereupon the aforesd Pitt of Thomas Browne his
 Attorney Complaineth for that whereas the aforesd Pitt in the year of our Lord
 Christ one thousand seven hundred and fourteen and untill this time at St Pauls
 Parish in Kent County within the Jurisdiction of this Court was an approved Inholder
 and Ordinary Keeper and as such sold vendid and delivered to diverse Inhabitants of
 this Province and other Persons diverse liquors and found and provided other suitable
 Accommodations during which said time of the said Pitts sleeping an Inn or
 Ordinary viz the twenty fourth day of November in the year of our Lord Christ
 one thousand seven hundred and sixteen at St Pauls Parish in Kent County within
 the Jurisdiction of this Court In Consideration that the aforesd Pitt at the
 speciall Instance and Request of the aforesd Defend: had then and there last said
 sold and delivered to the said Defend: and to the proper use and behoofe of the
 aforesaid Defend: diverse liquors and found and provided other suitable Accommodations
 in an Account hereto Annexed at the severall Rates and prices in the said Account sett
 forth in the whole amounting unto the sum of one pound eleven shillings & three
 pence Current Silver money of Maryland upon himself assumed and to the
 said Pitt then and there last mentioned faithfully promised that he the said
 Defend: the aforesd sum of one pound eleven shillings and three pence Current
 Silver money of Maryland to the said Pitt when thereunto required would well
 and truly pay and Content And that whereas also the aforesd Def: afterwards viz
 the aforesaid twenty fourth day of November in the year of our Lord Christ one
 thousand seven hundred and sixteen at St Pauls Parish in Kent County within
 the Jurisdiction of this Court In Consideration that the aforesd Pitt at the like
 speciall Instance and Request of the aforesd Defend: had then and there last mentioned
 sold and delivered to the aforesd Defend: and to the proper use and behoofe of the
 aforesaid Defend: diverse liquors and found and provided other suitable Accommodations
 in an Account hereto Annexed specifically sett forth upon himself assumed and
 to the said Pitt then and there last mentioned faithfully promised that he the said
