of six hundred pounds of tobacco Debt by the aforesd recovered against the  
said debt before the Justices of our said Court on the sixteenth day of March  
instant whereof he is bound as appears upon Record as also the sume of  
three hundred and eight pounds of tobacco cost of suit as also together with  
the sume of fourty six pounds of tobacco additional cost herof saile not at  
your perill and habe you then and there this coris M<sup>r</sup>ch<sup>s</sup> Attm<sup>s</sup>  
Thos<sup>r</sup>son Gent<sup>r</sup> Chief Justice of our said Court this twenty first day of March in the  
third year of our Domini m<sup>r</sup>ch<sup>s</sup> anno Domini 1717 R<sup>e</sup>turnd home Sim<sup>r</sup>on Wilmer

thousand Seven hundred and eighteen the day of return of said writ came
