WILL'S absolute Lord and proprietor of the Province of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Balkmore &c. To the Sheriff Kent County greeting We Command you that you take the body of Richard Fullstone of Kent County Cooper as did Richard Fullstone of Kent County in & of Province of Maryland Cooper if he should be found in his County with and him safe keep so that he have his body before the Justice of our next County Court to be held at our Court house in the Town of Quarter in said County on the third Tuesday in June next to satisfy unto Dennis Sullivan p^{ts} as well the Sum of Six hundred pounds of Tobacco Debt by the ap^{pt} p^{ts} recovered against the said Debt before the Justice of our said Court on the twentieth day of May Instant whereof he is Convict as appears upon Records as also the Sum of three hundred and eight pounds of Tobacco and p^{ts} as also together with the Sum of forty six pounds of Tobacco additional and hereof fail not at your peril and have you then and there this writ WITNESS Nathaniel Hyson Gent. chief Justice of our said Court this twenty first day of March in the third year of our Dominion &c. Anno Dom 1717

At which said next Court viz. the seventeenth day of June Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and eighteen the day of return of said writ came Simon Wilmer Gent.
