Endorsed as job by May 28<sup>th</sup> 1778 Then came the within named Parker  
Roe and made Oath to the within amount according to Act of Assembly  
before me R. Tilghman

and the app<sup>t</sup> By his app<sup>t</sup> pray that the D<sup>t</sup> Deft may to his D<sup>t</sup> app<sup>t</sup>  
and the app<sup>t</sup> Deft being called came and the said D<sup>t</sup> By his app<sup>t</sup> pray  
that the said Deft may give Special Bail to the app<sup>t</sup> Avon which is granted  
and that he be kept in safe Custody by the Sheriff of said County until he  
shall give Special Bail

after which William Pope of said County here in Court came and acknowledged  
himself as special bail in the app<sup>t</sup> Avon and doth undertake the payment  
of the Damages app<sup>t</sup> & Cost thereon accruing if the said D<sup>t</sup> shall be cast in  
the same and the Condemnation shall not satisfy nor himself to the  
Custody of the Sheriff of said County deliver or that the app<sup>t</sup> William Pope  
the body of the app<sup>t</sup> Deft shall not render to.

and the app<sup>t</sup> Deft in his proper person appears to the above Avon and says  
that he cannot pay the Avon app<sup>t</sup> of him the said app<sup>t</sup> nor but that the  
Damages above mentioned is what he is indebted to the app<sup>t</sup> and is willing  
that Judgement should be entered for the sum of five hundred fifty two  
pounds of Tobacco & Cost thereon accruing: Therefore it is Considered by the  
Court here on this eighteenth day of June Anno Domini One thousand Seven  
hundred and eighty two that the app<sup>t</sup> Parker Roe recover against  
the said Deft Nathaniel Dammoo as well the sum of five hundred  
& fifty two pounds of Tobacco Damages as also the sum of three hundred  
eighty eight pounds of Tobacco Cost by the app<sup>t</sup> about his side in this  
Cause Expended and by the Court here of his cost adjudged and the said  
Deft in mercy &c
