At which said next Court on the Seventeenth day of June Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and Eighteen the day of return of said writ came Simon Wilmer Gent. high Sheriff of said County and made return thereof in these words thereon Entered as folo by Copy Copy - *Wilmers Sherd.* And the said being filed taken said writ shewed forth & a Copy thereof served therewith according to Act of Assembly in such Case made was as followeth viz.
