Richard Marshall of Kent County Planter and Doct Richard Marshall of Kent County Planter was summoned to answer unto Charles Newman of a plea that he render him the sum of five hundred and fifty pounds of good sound merchantable leaf tobacco clear of ground taxes and all manner frack and charge to contain of some of y<sup>e</sup> price or value of five pounds sterb which from him he unjustly detaineth and whereupon the app ptt by Thomas Poone his attorney saith that whereas the said Deft the nineteenth day of January in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and fourteen at p<sup>r</sup>ouds parish in Kent County within the jurisdiction of this Court by his certain bill obligatory which he the said Deft sealed with his Seal and as his deed delivered hereinto Court brought the date whereof is the same day and year as bound himself his heirs Executors Administrators or assigns to pay to y<sup>e</sup> app ptt the app sum of five hundred and fifty pounds of good sound merchantable leaf tobacco clear of ground taxes and all manner frack and charge to contain of some of y<sup>e</sup> price or value of five pounds sterb due upon the tenth day of October next ensuing the date of the app bill obligatory yet the app Deft altho' often required the app sum of five hundred and fifty pounds of y<sup>e</sup> value or price of five pounds sterb as to the said ptt hath not paid but that to him to render or pay the said Deft further hath denied & still doth deny & unjustly detain to the damage of him the said ptt one thousand pounds of tobacco and thereupon he brings suite &c.

and the app Deft in his proper person appeared to the app Court and prayed liberty thereof to implead thereto and to answer at next Court which was granted the same day was given the ptt in like manner  
 At which said next Court viz this Eighteenth day of June Annoq<sup>o</sup> Domini One thousand Seven hundred and Eighteen came the app Deft
