Thereupon Commanded it was to the Sheriff of Kent County the Twentieth second day of November in the third Year of His Lordships Dominion &c. That the cause Joseph Milby late of St. Pauls parish in the County of Kent a Labourer if he should be found in his Bailiwick that all excuses & delays be sett apart he be & personally appear before the Justices of our next County Court to be held at our Court house in the Town of Chester in said County to answer unto to answer unto a Certain Bill of Indictment found against him for negligently behaving himselfe in the Business of our said Lord proprietarie as Constable of Langford Bay upper hundred in the County of Down and that he have there the said precept &c. At which said next Court on the eighteenth day of March the same Year last mentioned the day of return of said precept came Simon Wilmer Gentleman high Sheriff of said County and made return thereof in these words thereon Endorsed as follows by Simon Wilmer Sheriff.
