Jacob Glenn & Peter Williams both of this County entered into Recognizance at the Same time ap in the Sum of Ten pounds Sterling each for the use of the ap Thomas Coke as ap and to answer as ap &c. This Court here discharges the Same Recognizance each of them &c.

ordered by the Court here that the ap Thomas Coke be kept in Custody by the Sheriff of said County until he shall give Surety for his appearance to next Court and then to answer unto a Certain Judgment found against him for Conspiring and perverting of the Certain with a Certain Roberts Lynch &c.

Timothy Plauter an Ord. against the ap Thomas Coke ordered to Enter into Recognizance for his appearance to next Court

Timothy Plauter ap Comes into Court and acknowledges himselfe indebted to his Lordship his heirs & Successors in the Sum of five pounds Ster to be Levied on his goods & Chattells Lands and Tenements conditionally that if he do not make his personall appearance at the next Court as an Ord. against the ap Thomas Coke whereunto he is Content

Thomas Hughs an Ord. against Same be Committed into Custody of the Sheriff of said County until he should give his Evidence ag Same &c. now the ap Thomas undi proper person app. to Same this Court Order that he be discharged &c. Thomas Hughs ap is discharged from the said Commitment

Thomas Hughs ap comes into Court and acknowledges himselfe indebted to his Lordship his heirs and Successors in the Sum of five pounds Sterling to be Levied on his goods & Chattells Lands and Tenements conditionally that if he do not make his personall appearance at the next Court to be held for said County as an Ord. for his Lordship against the ap Thomas Coke whereunto he acknowledges himselfe Content

Michael Byrne Surety for the ap Thomas Hughs acknowledges himselfe indebted to his Lordship his heirs and Successors in the Sum of five pounds Sterling to be Levied on his Lands and Tenements goods & Chattells conditionally that if the ap Thomas Hughs shall not appear at the next County Court to be held for said County as an Ord. ag against the ap Thomas Coke whereunto he acknowledges himselfe Content.
