 that they render unto him the full & just Sum of sixteen hundred pounds of good
 Sound Merchantable leaf Tobacco clear of trash and ground leaves of the value
 of ten pounds Sterd which from him they unjustly detain &c. And that he
 have them and there the said writ &c. All which said next Court
 on the Seventeenth day of June Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred
 and eighteen the day of return of said writ came Simon Wilmer Gent. Sheriff
 of said County and made return thereof in these words Thereon Exposed as
 sold by John M Juvontus Edward Rouse Capt. Corpus Abraham Taylor &
 Simon Wilmer Ther. And a bill being filed w^{ch} writ sold by Kent County Abraham
 Taylor late of Kent County planter & Edward Rouse late of Kent County planter als Diut
 Abraham Taylor and Edward Rouse both of Queen Annis County planter & Carpenter
 were summoned to answer unto George Commerford Demin^d of all & singular the Goods
 & Chattells Rights & Credits which were of Elizabeth Commerford his late wife deces^d
 of a plea that they render unto him the full and just Sum of sixteen hundred
 pounds of good Sound Merchantable leaf Tobacco clear of trash and ground leaves
 of the value of Ten pounds Sterd which from him they unjustly detain &c. and
