

app Defts the twentieth day of November Anno Domini 1718 at the parish of St Pauls in Kent County app and within the jurisdiction of this Court by their Certain bill or writing obligatorily sealed with their Seals here into Court brought whose date is the day and year app did acknowledge themselves to be holden unto the said Eli in her life time in the said sum of fifteen hundred pounds of good sound tobacco leaf Tobacco clear of trash & ground leaves of the app value of fifteen pounds to be paid to the said Eli in her life time when they should be thereunto required yet nevertheless the app Defts nor either of them the said fifteen hundred pounds of Tobacco to y<sup>e</sup> said Elizabeth in her life time while she was the said app after the espousals between them celebrated nor to the said app since the death of the said Elizabeth hath hitherto paid or made content but to pay the same to the said Eli in her life time or to the said app since the espousals or to the said app since the death of the said Eli hath hitherto refused and to the said app will doth refuse to y<sup>e</sup> damage of the said app fifteen pounds and thereupon he brings suit &c.

And the app Deft Abraham Taylor being called came and the app app by his app atty prays that the app Deft. may give special baile to the app Elion &c is granted and that he be kept in safe custody by the Sheriff of said County until he shall give special baile. after which James Connally of said County came into Court and acknowledged himselfe special baile in the above action and doth undertake for the app Abraham Taylor the payment of the debt app and cost thereon accruing if the Deft app should be cast in y<sup>e</sup> same and the condemnation should not satisfye nor himselfe to the custody of the Sheriff of said County deliver or that the app James Connally the body of the app Abraham Taylor shall not render &c.

After which the app Deft Abraham Taylor came and in his proper person appeared to the above action and saith that he cannot give any baile app of the app app nor but that the writing obligatorily above mentioned is void and dead and that he sweth unto the app app the sume app and is willing that judgment should be entered for the app app & cost thereon accruing therefore it is considered by the Court here by this nineteenth day of June Anno Domini One thousand seven hundred and Eighteen that the app app George Connersford Comrall was app Receiver against the app Deft Abraham Taylor as well the app sume of fifteen hundred pounds of Tobacco the debt app as also the sume of two hundred eighty one pounds of Tobacco lost by the app app about his site in this behalf expended and by the Court here of his absent adjudged and the said Deft in mercy &c.
