after which Charles Smith and Benjamin Bond both of said County came into Court and Acknowledges themselves jointly and severally bound in the aforesaid and they and either of them do undertake for the aforesaid Debt the payment of the Debt and of all thereon arising if it should happen that the said Debt shall be ask in the same and the Condemnation shall not satisfy nor himself to the Custody of the Sheriff of said County deliver or that the aforesaid Charles Smith and Benjamin Bond or either of them the body of the said Debt shall not render &c

All the aforesaid in his proper person appears to the aforesaid Court and saith that he cannot gainsay the Oath of him the said Plaintiff nor but that the writing obligatory above mentioned is his Act and deed and that he oweth unto the aforesaid Plaintiff the sum of eight hundred and four pounds of Tobacco and is willing that Judgment should be entered against him for the same therefore it is considered by the Court here by this Nineteenth day of June Anno Domini One Thousand Seven Hundred and Eighteen that the aforesaid Plaintiff Michael Byrne recover against the said Debt Peter Williams as well the aforesaid sum of five hundred and seventy pounds of Tobacco and the sum of two hundred thirty four pounds of Tobacco the aforesaid which in the whole amounts to the sum of eight hundred and four pounds of Tobacco Debt as also the sum of two hundred ninety three pounds of Tobacco lost by the aforesaid Plaintiff about his Rite in that behalf expended and by the Court here of his own accord and the said Debt in mercy &c
