State of Maryland, Caroline County to wit; Whereas applications hath been made to me by John Boston for a Certificate of his freedom agreeably to the acts of Assembly in such cases made and provided, by which said acts free negroes and mulattos are permitted to travel out of this State upon the obtention of a Certificate of being free born; and Whereas also upon the oath of Salisbury Cochran of Caroline County that the said negro man named John Boston for whom this Certificate is made, was free born; I do therefore grant his said application and hereby Certify that from his own account he was twenty one years of age on the twenty sixth day of October last past, five feet five and three quarter inches high or thereabouts, of a Brown Complexion was born and raised in Caroline County and has a scar of a cut on the left foot a cross his big toe, just about the first joint and has another scar of a cut on the left side of his face between his cheek and eye and has no other marks or scars that I have observed -
