State of Maryland Caroline County to wit; Whereas heretofore to wit on the twenty third day of December seventeen hundred and ninety nine, a certain Sarah Huddleston and Solomon Kenton of Caroline County by deed of Manumission duly executed and acknowledged among the Land records of Caroline County, did manumit and set free among others a negro man called Stephen, to be free and at perfect liberty on the first day of January eighteen hundred and seven, and the said negroman named Stephen, having made application to me for a certificate of freedom agreeable to the acts of Assembly in such case made and provided; and whereas also upon the oaths of Eliza Atkinson of Caroline County that the said negroman Stephen for whom is this certificate is made is the same person mentioned in said manumission, I do therefore grant his said application and hereby certify that from his age expressed in said manumission he was fifty six years of age on the 23^d day of December last past five feet seven inches high or thereabouts complexion nearly black born and raised in Talbot County his fore finger on his left hand crooked at the last joint and has a scar or cut on his right hand between his wrist and thumb, and has no other notable mark or scars that I have observed.
