And Whereas also upon the oath of James Sangster of Caroline County, that the said negro woman named Sarah for whom this certificate is the same person mentioned in said Manumission I do therefore grant her said application, and hereby certify her age as expressed in the said Manumission, she was thirty nine years of age on the nineteenth day of June last past. five feet, three inches high on threeabouts of amulattoe complexion & raised in Caroline County and has a scar of a cut on her right arm just above the elbow joint and has no other notable marks or scars that I have observed.
