And whereas also upon the oath of John Dandabury of Caroline County aforesaid that the said negro woman named Maria Holiday for whom this certificate is made was free born, I do therefore grant her said application and hereby certify that from her account she is about twenty five years of age five feet six and three quarters inches high or thereabouts of a black complexion, born and raised in Caroline County, and has a scar of a burn on the right side of her breast or neck, and a natural mark on the under part of her left arm, near the armpit, and has no other notable marks or scars that I have observed.
