

State of Maryland, Caroline County, to wit; Whereas application hath been made to me by a mulatto woman named Lincy Fountain for a certificate of her freedom agreeably to the acts of a assembly in such cases made and provided, by which said acts free negroes and mulattoes are permitted to travel out of this state upon the obtention of a certificate of being free born; and whereas also upon the oath of Hugh Taylor of Caroline County aforesaid, that the said mulatto woman named Lincy Fountain for whom this certificate is made was free born; I do therefore grant her said application and hereby certify that from her own account she was twenty eight years of age on the thirty first day of March last past, five feet, three and a quarter inches high or thereabouts, was born and raised in Caroline County, complexion Brown mulatto, and has a small black mole on her left collar bone, and a small flesh mole near her chin, and a scar of a cut on the top of her right hand and has no other notable marks or scars that I have observed -

State of Maryland, Caroline County, to wit; Whereas application hath been made to me by a mulatto man named Henry King for a certificate of his freedom agreeably to the act of a assembly in such case made and provided, by which said acts free negroes and mulattoes are permitted to travel out of this state upon the obtention of a certificate of being free born; and whereas also upon the oath of Arthur John Willis of Caroline County aforesaid, that the said negro man named Henry King for whom this certificate is made was free born; I do therefore grant his said application and hereby certify that from his own account he was twenty two years of age some time in March last past, five feet six inches high or thereabouts, was born and raised in Caroline County, of a Brown mulatto complexion, and has several large scars on his right leg. and has no other notable marks or scars that I have observed -
