the twenty ninth day of March Eighteen hundred and forty, And whereas the
said negro woman named Cynthia having made application to me for a Certificate of
her freedom, agreeably to the acts of Assembly in such Cases made and provided; And
whereas also upon the oath of Thomas M. Wood of Caroline County aforesaid, that
the said negro woman named Cynthia for whom this Certificate is made, is the same
person mentioned in the said Manumission. I do therefore grant her said application
and hereby Certify from her age expressed in said manumission she was thirty five years
of age in March last past, five feet, two and one half inches or thereabouts, was born
and raised in Caroline County, Complexion black, and has a large scar of a cut over
her right eye, and just in the edge of the wool ^{on} her head, and two other scars
occasioned by the bite of a dog on her right arm and has no other notable marks or
scars that I have observed. —
