Whittors of Caroline County aforesaid, that the said, negro man named Andrew Henry for whom this Certificate is made was free born, I do therefore grant his said Application and hereby Certify that from his father account he was twenty two years of age on the first day of March last past, five feet three and a half inches high or thereabouts, was born and raised in Caroline County, and of a mulatto Complexion, and the ring finger of his left hand is a little deformed by a gathering as he says, and has no other notable marks or scars that I have observed. —

State of Maryland, Caroline County Court; Whereas applications hath been made to me by a negro man named Samuel Hawkins for a Certificate of his freedom agreeably to the act of Assembly in such Cases made and provided, by which said acts free negroes and mulattoes are permitted to travel out of this State upon the obtention of a Certificate of being free born, And Whereas also upon the oaths of Jonathan Spencer of Caroline County aforesaid that the said negro man named Samuel Hawkins for whom this Certificate is made was free born; I do therefore grant his said Application and hereby Certify that from his own account he is now about twenty three years of age, five feet eight inches high or thereabouts, was born in Queen Anne's County and raised in Caroline County aforesaid, and of a brown Complexion and has two small scars on his left elbow joint and has no other notable marks or scars that I have observed. —
