Barwick of Caroline county aforesaid, that the said negro woman named Sarah Ann Green for whom this certificate is made was free born; I do therefore grant her said application and hereby certify that from her mother's account she was fourteen years of age some time in July last past five feet three inches high or thereabouts, was born and raised in Caroline County aforesaid and of a black complexion, and has a small scar of a cut on her left cheek and has no other notable marks or scars that I have observed -
