

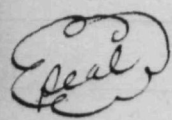

State of Maryland, Caroline County, to wit; Whereas application hath
been made to me by a negro woman named Milly Farmer, for a certificate
of her freedom agreeably to the acts of assembly in such case made and
provided, by which said acts free negroes and mulattoes are permitted
to travel out of this state upon the obtention of a certificate of being
free born; and whereas also upon the oath of Joshua Clarke of Caroline
County aforesaid, that the said negro woman named Milly Farmer
for whom this certificate is made was free born; I do therefore grant
her said application and hereby certify that from her own account
she is now about fifty years of age four feet eleven and three quarters
inches high or thereabouts, was born and raised in Caroline County
and of a Chestnut complexion, and has no notable marks or scars
that I have observed —
