 or thereabouts, of a bright molatto complexion was born and raised in Caroline
 County, has a very small scar of a cut on the left side of his nose, and three
 other scars of a different size about the ~~hand~~ joint of his little finger, and a
 large scar of a cut across his ^{right} wrist, and no other notable marks or scars that
