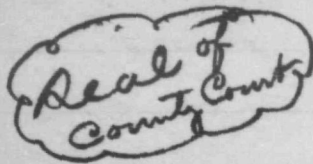


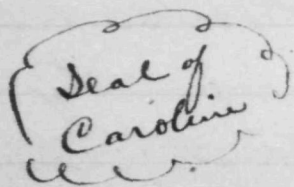

Certificate is made was free born, I do therefore grant her said
application and hereby Certify that from her own account she
was seventeen years of age on the twenty ninth day of July last
past, four feet eleven inches high or thereabouts was born and
raised in Caroline County. Complexion Chestnut Colour and has
no notable marks or scars that I have observed.
