

State of Maryland Caroline County to wit, Whereas on the twenty third day of November 1847 a certain Christopher Green of Caroline County by deed of Manumission duly executed acknowledged and recorded among the Land Records of Caroline County did manumit and set free from and after the date of said Manumission a certain negro man named William Green and application being made to me by William Green for a certificate of his freedom agreeably to the act of Assembly in such case made and provided, And whereas also upon the oath of Abraham Dumps of Caroline County aforesaid that the said negro man named William Green is the same and identical person named in said deed of Manumission and that the said negro man named William Green is now free, I do therefore grant his said application and hereby certify that from his own account he is now about twenty four years of age five feet six inches high or thereabouts was born and raised in Caroline County Complexion black and has a scar of a burn on the Left wrist joint extending up the arm & a scar of a cut on the Left knee joint & has no other notable marks or scars that I have observed.
