

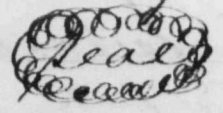

 application hath been made to me by a negro ~~man~~ named George W.
 Caldwell for a certificate of his freedom agreeably to the acts of Assembly
 in such case made and provided by which said acts free negroes and
 mulattos are permitted to travel out of this state upon the exhibition
 of a certificate of being free born. And whereas also upon the oath
 of Sarah Weather of Caroline County aforesaid that the said negro
 man named George W. Caldwell for whom this Certificate is made
 was free born. I do therefore grant his said application and
 hereby certify that from his own account he is now about twenty
 one years of age, five feet, four & a half inches high or thereabouts, ^a dark
 Chestnut Complexion, was born and raised in Caroline County
 aforesaid, and has a large scar or mark on the left arm below
 the elbow & has no other notable marks or scars that I have ob-
 served.
