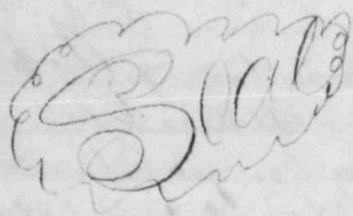


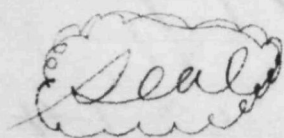

hath been made to me by a negro man named Samuel
Henry Hamilton for a certificate of his freedom agreeably
to the acts of Assembly in such case made and provided
by which said acts free negroes and mulattoes are permitted
to travel out of this State upon the obtaining of a certificate
of being free born, and whereas also upon the oath of
Cornelius Conroy of Caroline County aforesaid that the
said Samuel Henry Hamilton for whom this certificate
is made was free born, I do therefore grant his said
application and hereby certify that from his own account
he is now about twenty one years of age, five feet
six inches high or thereabouts of a dark ^{complexion} complexion
was born and raised in Caroline County aforesaid &
has a scar on the right knee, occasioned by a cut
and has no other notable marks or scars that I
have observed
