State of Maryland Caroline County Court: Whereas
hitherto on the 29th day of March 1825 a certain
George A. Smith did manumit and set free a
certain negro girl named Emma to be free on the 1st
of January 1830. And whereas application hath
been made to me by a mulatto woman calling herself
Emma Lucas for a certificate of her freedom agree-
ably to the act of Assembly in such case made and
provided: And whereas on the Oath of Owen Brown
she is the same one mentioned in said Manumission
I do therefore grant her this Certificate. She is about
30 years of age five feet two inches high or thereabouts of
a bright mulatto complexion with no notable scars.
