Station Rhodes of Caroline County that the coloured woman named Mary Rich for whom this Certificate is made was free born; I do therefore grant her said application and hereby certify, that from her mother's account she is about nineteen years of age, five feet four inches high or thereabouts, was born and raised in Caroline County, of a dark mulatto or light brown complexion, has a small scar at the outer corner of her right eye brow, and no other notable marks or scars that I have observed —
