day of June in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and two a certain Charles Blain
by Deed of Manumission duly executed acknowledged and recorded among the Land
records of Caroline County did manumit and set free a certain negro girl named
Annied to be free from and after the first day of January eighteen hundred and
twenty one, and the said negro girl named Annied having made application to me
for a certificate of her freedom agreeably to the act of assembly in such cases made
and provided and whereas also upon the Testimony of Doctor John Stevens of Talbot
County that the said negro girl named Annied for whom this certificate is made is
the same person mentioned in the said manumission; I do therefore grant her
said application and hereby certify that from her age as expressed in the said
manumission she will be twenty nine years of age the second day of June
next five feet and one quarter of an inch high or thereabouts was born in
~~Talbot~~ ^{Caroline} and raised in ~~Caroline~~ ^{Talbot} County of a brown complexion has a long scar of a
scratches on the left arm extending from the middle of the back of her wrist
more than half way to her elbow, and another scar of a cut just above her left elbow,
and another scar above the last on the same arm caused as she says by the bite of a
spider, of an oval form and as large or larger than half a dollar and no other
notable marks or scars that I have observed. —
