State of Maryland Caroline County to wit, Whereas heretofore to wit: on the twenty first day of February eighteen hundred and four, a certain Anthony Rofs by Deed of manumission duly executed, acknowledged and recorded among the Land records of Caroline County did manumit and set free a certain negro woman named Tall (now calling herself Sarah Gibson) to be free on the first day of January eighteen hundred and five; and the said negro woman named Tall (now calling herself Sarah Gibson) having made application to me for a Certificate of her freedom agreeably to the act of Assembly in such case made and provided, and whereas also upon the oath of Sarah Perry of Caroline County that the said negro woman named Tall (now calling herself Sarah Gibson) is the same person mentioned in the said manumission; I do therefore grant her said application and hereby certify that from her age as expressed in the said manumission, she is about forty seven years of age, five feet four and three quarter inches high or thereabouts, of a dark complexion, was born and raised in Caroline County, has one scar on the left side of her forehead, and no other notable marks or scars that I have observed. —
