State of Maryland, Caroline County, to wit; Whereas heretofore, to wit, on the thirtieth day of October, in the year of our Lord seventeen hundred and ninety two, a certain Henry Downes of Caroline County, by Deeds of Nomination duly executed, acknowledged and recorded among the Land records of Caroline County aforesaid, did nominate and set free a negro woman called Emmie to be free on the twenty fourth day of December eighteen hundred and twenty, And whereas the said negro woman named Emmie hath this day made application to me for a certificate of her freedom agreeably to the act of assembly in such cases made and provided, and being satisfied by the oath of Mahala Cooper that the said negro woman Emmie is the same person mentioned in the said nomination, I do therefore grant her said application and hereby certify that from her own account, she is forty one years of age or thereabouts, five feet two and a quarter inches high or thereabouts, of a complexion nearly black, was born and raised in Caroline County and has a small scar of a cut on the thick part of the inside of her right arm just below the elbow joint and no other notable marks or scars that I have observed.
