I do therefore grant her said application and hereby certify that from her own account she was twenty four years of age the first day of April Instant five feet high or thereabouts of a brown complexion was born and raised in Caroline County and has a large scar of a burn on the left side of her neck just under her jaw and no other notable marks or scars that I have observed.
